



Confluencias by Melón Jiménez & Lara Wong in Toronto



Guitarist Melón Jiménez and flautist Lara Wong debut their project “Confluencias” in Ottawa, blending flamenco-inspired rhythms and melodies with electronic soundscapes and mystical bansuri tunes.

After two years of composing, performing, and touring together, the duo of guitarist Melón Jiménez and flautist Lara Wong, who also plays the bansuri (an Indian flute), presents their new project, *Confluencias*, at BSMT254.

This project blends rhythms and melodies inspired by flamenco. In a dialogue between cultures, *Confluencias* takes audiences on a musical journey filled with flamenco guitar riffs, electronic soundscapes, mystical bansuri melodies, and flute improvisations.

They will be accompanied on this occasion by George Crotty (cello), Lia Grainger (dance) and Tamar Ilana (vocals).

Guitarist [Melón Jiménez](#) is dedicated to both the tradition of his Andalusian gypsy roots and the pursuit of innovative, avant-garde guitar sounds. Born into a musically and culturally diverse family —his mother is a German classical pianist and his father a flamenco guitarist from Jerez de la Frontera— Jiménez has developed a unique guitar style. He incorporates various techniques and sounds that he has explored throughout his career.

His versatility has allowed him to collaborate with artists like Anoushka Shankar, Richard Bona, Jorge Pardo, and Niña Pastori at prestigious festivals around the world.
