Tomatito is one of the most important and acclaimed Flamenco guitarists in the world. He won a Latin Grammy for the album *Aguadulce*, a tribute to his birthplace. His unique approach both to the traditional, festive forms and genre experimentation highlight his unprecedented musical sensitivity and interpretative power.

A charismatic personality and an unrelenting commitment to the continuity of flamenco's development have brought him worldwide recognition not only in the musical field but also in film, theatre and art. He has collaborated with a multitude of performers from all over the globe and has encouraged and influenced a whole generation of young artists.
